It is again my great pleasure to make this report on behalf of the Vincentians from Ontario.

**Expansion:** A new Conference has been formed in Elliot Lake and this is hoped to be only the beginning in our North. We have also had contact with a group from Kingston and it is hoped something will be forthcoming. Our youth membership is getting stronger and we have recently received an inquiry to form a Youth Conference at the High School in Cobourg, Ontario. In 2000 we had 4 Conferences aggregated.

**Charitable Work:** Ontario contributed to international relief a total of \$185,720.00. In addition, we supported our National Council \$41,000.00.
