To clarify the duty to support higher level Councils, the National Board has proclaimed this policy Financial Contributions to National . This is NOT a change in responsibility but does provide the clarifying terminology of National Support Fee (replacing "annual pass up").

To be consistent, ONRC will now use the term "Regional Support Fee" to describe the \$300 to be provided annually by each conference/Council in the region to support the work of ONRC.
